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Please be advised that there will be an adjustment to the wage package for the **CEMENT MASONS** of **LOCAL 11, AREA 638** (Kane, Kendall, DeKalb, & McHenry Counties) effective **JUNE 1, 2015** and extending through **MAY 31, 2016**.

After tax deductions:

* Effective June 1, 2015, the rate of contribution for the Tax Deferred Income Fund will be \$9.11 for straight time hours worked, \$13.67 for all hours worked at time and one half, and \$18.22 for all hours worked at double time.

** Effective for all hours worked after June 1, 2015 a **vacation fund** has been approved by members of Local 11, Area 638. This is an “after tax” deduction from members payroll check. Contractors are to deduct \$4.05 an hour for **straight time** hours (\$6.08 for hours worked at **time and one half** and \$8.10 per hour for **double-time** hours) to be submitted to our administrator along with the normal pension and welfare benefits

* Overtime rates are as follows: Double the regular rate of pay during the week (Monday through Friday) **and time and one half the regular rate of pay on Saturdays**

REMINDER: Any Cement Mason who is discharged or laid off shall be paid by cash or check in person or by mail postmarked within 48 hours to the nearest working day. In the event an Employer does not send the check promptly postmarked within 48 hours to the nearest workday, a 4 hour penalty shall be assessed for each day postmarked after the initial 48 hours, payable directly to the affected Cement Mason, and the Union reserves the right to deny the said Employer privilege of mailing future check. Please see Section 3, Paragraph 8, for further explanation.
